



Good afternoon parents/guardians,

As you know, an individual with COVID-19 may be contagious before showing visible signs of the virus. As such, we knew that it was quite possible that we may experience another case or more of students that are COVID-19 positive at this time.

We have been informed of a third student who has tested positive for the virus. This individual is a sophomore and was in the building yesterday, October 13. If your child was in class with this individual, you will be notified shortly.

Also, I learned more information about one student of whom I spoke of yesterday. The last day the junior was in the building during an in-person school day was as stated, Friday, the 9th. However, a small group of students were in one area of the building with this student on Monday, the 12th. This group of students have been notified separately as the quarantine period is slightly different.

This new information does not affect the virtual learning schedule which began today as it was calculated based on yesterday's date. The school is still scheduled to re-open for in-person instruction on Tuesday, October 27.

I am still responding to some emails regarding families with multiple children. The new emails going out shortly will have your child's name in the email so you will know exactly which child the notice pertains to. Thank you for your patience.
