approved by President Franklin D. Roosevelt on August 4, 1937. The MCL is the only Federally Chartered Marine Corps related veterans organization in the country. Today the league boasts a membership of more than 76,000 men and women, officer and enlisted, Active Duty, Reserve Marines, honorably discharged Marine Veterans and qualified Navy FMF Corpsmen and is one of the few Veterans Organizations that experiences increases in its membership each year. Additionally, the MCL welcomes Associate Members including honorably discharged veterans of other branches of the United States Military service.

Eligible student applicants must be current residents of Somerset County and currently enrolled in a high school located in Somerset County or a U.S Military Veteran who resides in Somerset County and is enrolling in an accredited college/university or trade school. Selected applicants must attend the MCL June meeting (4th Wednesday of the month, 7:30 pm, Manville–Hillsborough Elks Lodge #2119) to receive their award and must agree to the use of their name and photograph to be published by various media sources (local newspapers, MCL #1284 Facebook page, website and other sources utilized by the detachment to demonstrate its community support and involvement).

Selection: Applicants must complete the attached **2-page application with essay requirement** by the prescribed deadline. Any scholarship(s) will be selected and presented by the Scholarship Committee of MCL Detachment #1284, as delegated by MCL Detachment #1284's Commandant.
