



Schoology is Immaculata's Learning Management System. PowerSchool, LLC acquired Schoology in 2019, and discontinued PowerSchool Learning/Haiku in favor of Schoology in 2022 (hence our transition from PSL to Schoology that same year).

It is important for all students to know how to log into and navigate Schoology, as teachers will use this platform to post assignments and resources on their class webpages / "feed." Parents are also encouraged to regularly log into Schoology to support their child's academic progress. Any student or parent needing assistance accessing Schoology should contact Immaculata's Technology Department by sending an email to service@immaculatahighschool.org.

## Student and Teacher Login:

To login, students should go to <a href="http://immaculata.schoology.com">http://immaculata.schoology.com</a>. This link can also be found on Immaculata's website. Once at this web address, students will automatically be asked to login with Schoology's Google integration, and should proceed to enter their Immaculata G Suite email address and password.

## Parent Login:

To login, parents should go to <a href="http://immaculata.schoology.com/login">http://immaculata.schoology.com/login</a>, using the username and password provided to them at the beginning of the child(ren)'s time at Immaculata (or the beginning of the 2022-2023 academic year).



## Schoology App:

The Schoology App is available for Apple and Android devices (see icon on the right). However, the web version of Schoology is still the method most recommended by Immaculata's Technology Department to access class webpages and other information.

To login, all students, teachers, and parents should first search for and select "Immaculata High School (5915113615)." After selecting Immaculata, students and teachers should select "Log in Through Your School" (and use Schoology's Google integration to login), which is the blue button shown in the screenshot on the left. Parents should select "Log in using Schoology.com" (and use the username and password provided to them), which is the white button shown in the screenshot on the left.
